


## **Change Chrome Languages & Translate Webpages**

You can change the language Chrome uses and have Chrome translate webpages for you.


## Request translation or turn translation off

You can control whether Chrome will offer to translate webpages.

- 1. On your computer, open Chrome.
- 2. At the top right, click More Settings.
- 3. At the bottom, click Advanced.



- 4. Under "Languages," click Language.
- 5. Check or uncheck "Offer to translate pages that aren't in a language you read."



When you come across a page written in a language you don't understand, you can use Chrome to translate the page.

- 1. On your computer, open Chrome.
- 2. Go to a webpage written in another language.
- 3. At the top, click Translate.



4. Chrome will translate the webpage this one time.

Not working? Try refreshing the webpage. If it's still not working, right-click anywhere on the page. Then, click Translate to [Language].

By default, Chrome offers to translate pages written in a language you don't understand.
